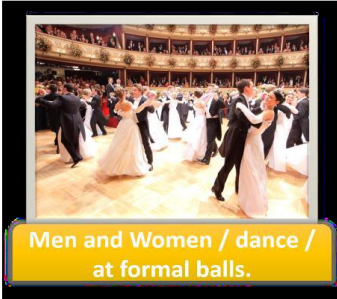

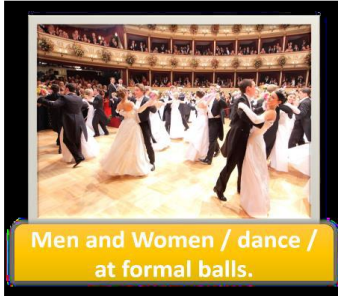

- A+ Yes, they did.
- A+ Yes, that's right.
- A+ Yes, that's right **BECAUSE**

- + Men **used to** carry walking sticks / walking canes.
- Men **didn't use to** carry walking sticks / walking canes.
- ? **Did** men **use to** carry walking sticks / walking canes?
